Welcome back to a fun filled term, we hope you had an enjoyable break. This term we have started with a fire safety talk from Firefighter Dan. Your child should be able to tell you the number to call in an emergency, the rhyme to remind them to stay away from matches and lighters as well as how often you should be checking your fire alarm.

This term's topic is called 'Explosions of Light' and is all about fireworks, the gunpowder plot and other celebrations. In Literacy we will be learning to read and write poetry, and instructions. We will be continuing to develop our knowledge of sounds through Read, Write, Inc. sessions. Please support your child at home by continuing to read regularly, and practise the key words which will be at the back of the contact books.

In mathematics the children will be continuing to add and subtract numbers to 10, they will be learning about positions such as first, second etc and will be developing their knowledge of numbers to 20.

On Friday 4th November Year One will be experiencing a day all about fire, we will have a fire out on the field and will be using sparklers. If you do not want your child to use a sparkler please let your child's teacher know, otherwise please provide your child with a pair of gloves.

Please ensure your child wears a coat to school every day as British weather can be unpredictable. As the weather turns please make sure your child has a hat, scarf and gloves **that are named**.


